Fire Procedures

Emergency Procedure Plans cover specific action to be taken by all personnel in attendance during non-medical emergencies such as fire.

All personnel, upon employment, are to be made familiar with the location of the fire extinguisher and how to use it in case of a fire.

Fire extinguishers are inspected and serviced by Massachusetts Fire Technologies (413-781-8000) on a yearly basis.


Signs are present in each room and inspected yearly by the fire department.

If any employee notices smoke or fire, they are to call 911 and all patients/clients/staff will be notified. Administrator or manager on site will determine if evacuation is necessary.
